DRUG PREVENTION PROGRAM CERTIFICATION

The Klein Independent School District, in accordance with the requirements in the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act (P.L. 101-226) and as a condition of the receipt of any federal funds and/or federal financial assistance, has developed the following statement regarding conduct that must be made to all staff members and provided to the Texas Education Agency for their official records:

- ❖ The unlawful possession, use or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol on school premises or as part of its activities is considered to be reprehensible conduct.
- ❖ Violators will be subject to the provisions of Board of Trustees' policy C-61 that appears in all staff handbooks and any infractions will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Compliance with the requirements and prohibitions of this legislation is a mandatory condition of employment.

Information pertaining to Houston-area drug and alcohol counseling and rehabilitation programs is published annually in the Klein School News. Copies are available from the human resource department and the office of the superintendent of schools for Klein ISD.
